Introduction




- The adult smoking rate is 20.6 % for Floyd county while the Healthy people 2020 goal is 12%.
- Our quality study was to evaluate the number of patients referred to the Georgia Quit Line. While all patients are assessed for current smoking, very few had a completed referral to the Georgia Quit Line.

Findings and Conclusions



- Key Findings:
 - From January 1, 2016 until June 30, 2016, a total of 20 patients were assisted with a completed referral to the Georgia Quit Line with 8 successful attempts based on data obtained from the Georgia Quit Line. While in Floyd County alone, the adult smoking percentage rate is 20.6 %.
 - Further work to improve quality will be ongoing.
